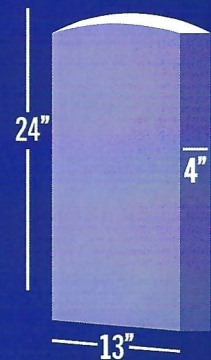

Veteran's name inscribed on front and spouse's name inscribed on the back. 230 lbs. and made of white marble or quartz.
